NPS Drug Policy

In accordance with federal law, the Newaygo Public School Board of Education prohibits of use, possession, concealment, or distribution of drugs on school grounds, in school or school approved vehicles, or at any school-related event.

Drugs include any alcoholic beverage, anabolic steroid, any controlled substance as defined by state statue, or any substance that could be considered a "look-a-like" controlled substance.

Compliance with this policy is mandatory. Any student who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action, in accordance with due process and as specified in the student handbooks, up to and including expulsion from school. When required by state law, the district will also notify law enforcement officials.

If you are aware of a student who is victim to alcohol or drug abuse, please contact the child's principal, counselor, or social worker immediately. At Newaygo Public Schools, we are concerned about our students and will readily facilitate the process of providing help through programs and services available in the community.
