#### Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Newaygo High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Mrs. Gena Dietz for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the following website Annual Report Data, , or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not identified as any of the aforementioned labels.

The school faces several key challenges as outlined in the Annual Education Report, primarily centered around persistent gaps in student achievement. Data reveals disparities in academic performance across various demographic groups, indicating a pressing need for targeted interventions. To address these challenges and accelerate student achievement, the school has implemented several key initiatives. One notable approach involves leveraging research-based Kagan structures in the classroom. These cooperative learning strategies foster active engagement and collaboration among students, promoting a supportive learning environment conducive to academic growth. Additionally, teachers are differentiating their lessons to address individual student needs, ensuring that each learner receives targeted support to reach their full potential. Furthermore, Professional Learning Communities (PLC) for our educators are being prioritized to enhance instructional practices and effectively meet the diverse needs of students. By combining these initiatives with ongoing data analysis and evidence-based decision-making, the school is committed to closing persistent gaps in achievement and fostering equitable outcomes for all students.

State law requires that we also report additional information regarding curriculum, programs offered, and parent involvement. Our teaching staff has been diligently working to establish a guaranteed and viable curriculum in each subject matter. Stakeholders may contact the school to request the curriculum for a class at any time.

Furthermore, we extend opportunities for students to pursue a dual enrollment pathway and enroll in honors courses, aimed at fostering their readiness for a prosperous transition beyond high school. Since autumn 2022, our dual enrollment initiative has seen active participation from 57 students, resulting in the attainment of 188 college credits, with an additional 46 credits currently in progress. Additionally, students who have participated in the Early College opportunity over the last two years have earned a total of 87 college credits with 30 more college credits currently in progress. Moreover, students are afforded the option to sit for Advanced Placement (AP) exams, enabling them to accrue college credit. Over the past two years, students have collectively undertaken 20 AP exams spanning seven distinct subject domains. Notably, five students achieved the highest score of 5, while two attained a score of 4, and a further five secured a score of 3, thereby earning college credits for their accomplishments.

At NHS, we highly value the engagement of parents and guardians in the discourse surrounding student progress, exemplified through our parent-teacher conferences. Recent data indicates a participation rate ranging between 10% and 20% during our fall session. Efforts are underway amongst our educators to devise strategies aimed at enhancing parent attendance at these crucial events, thereby fostering greater collaboration and support in the educational journey of our students.

As we conclude this year's Annual Education Report, I extend my heartfelt congratulations to our students, parents, teachers, and staff for their unwavering dedication and commitment to academic excellence. Your collective efforts have undoubtedly contributed to the positive strides we've made in advancing student achievement and fostering a thriving learning community. As we reflect on our accomplishments, let us also remain steadfast in our resolve to address any challenges that lie ahead. Together, we will continue to nurture a culture of continuous improvement, innovation, and inclusivity, ensuring that every student has the opportunity to succeed.
